WHAT

The New SAT differs significantly from previous SATs. It attempts to be more aligned with academic coursework and classroom problem solving. As such, the New SAT attempts to break new ground in both Math and Reading.

The Math section of the test adheres more closely to Common Core principles, where multi-step number processing is the order of the day. The Reading section attempts to evaluate complex analytical thinking with the emphasis on rhetoric, requiring students to evaluate passages based on textual evidence and narrative structure.

My course delves deeply into the strategies and techniques students need to obtain top scores on the new test.

Note: My spring class sells out quickly. Early registration is HIGHLY recommended.

WHEN

Friday -- 3:45 AM to 5:45 PM — 14 classes, including one take-home exam (Jan 27 - April 30th)

OR

Saturday -- 11 AM to 1 PM — 14 classes, including one take-home exam (Jan 28 - April 30th)

BREAKS

No class during spring break, week of April 2nd to April 8th. Over spring break, students receive a SAT take-home packet to tackle on their own, using the strategies and techniques they've learned in class. **No other breaks scheduled.**

WHICH SAT
